We make sure that all children have access to, a range of books, puzzles and other toys which provide positive images and examples of the diversity of life in our society.

We challenge racist and discriminatory remarks, attitudes and behaviour from the children in our care and from other adults they may come into contact with.

We help children to feel good about themselves and others by celebrating the differences which make us all unique.
